Energy Experience



Chevron Australia Master Contractor Services Contract

AusGroup was awarded an ongoing contract in 2015, which was recently extended to 2030, to provide brownfield maintenance and support services for the operational phase of Chevron Australia's Wheatstone LNG, Wheatstone Platform Gorgon LNG, WA Oil and Thevenard Island assets.

The scope includes front-line and campaign maintenance, brownfield execution scopes, turnarounds, and planned and unplanned outages.

AusGroup are providing comprehensive managed solutions using multi-disciplinary teams covering a complete range of services for the Chevron assets.



ESSO Scaffold and Insulation Services

AusGroup was engaged to supply scaffold material and insulation services as part of its multidisciplinary services contract with Esso's Sriracha Refinery in Thailand.

The scope also includes routine maintenance, shut down services and project work.



Woodside-operated North West Shelf Project - Fabrication Services

AusGroup (AGC) was engaged to provide fabrication, procurement and associated services to Woodside Energy Limited's North West Shelf Project.

The scope of work covers all Woodside-managed gas-producing assets, including the Karratha Gas Plant, Goodwyn 'A' Platform and the North Rankin 'A' Platform. The work includes small to medium sized fabrication projects, each designed to extend asset life.

The contract has been renewed each year for the past fourteen years, reflecting AGC's sustained and successful delivery of cost effective, high quality, reliable services.



INPEX-operated Ichthys LNG Project - Painting, Surface Protection, Fireproofing & Insulation

From 2015 to 2018 a joint venture between AGC Industries Pty Ltd and Meisei Industrial Co. Ltd of Japan was awarded a contract for the onshore facilities of the INPEX-operated Ichthys LNG Project near Darwin.

The subcontracted scope of work included painting, surface protection, fireproofing, and insulation works for lead contractor JKC Australia.



INPEX-operated Ichthys LNG Project - Module Insulation and Scaffolding

From 2013 to 2016, AGC Thailand was subcontracted to CUEL Limited, an engineering and construction contractor in the Asia Pacific region for works relating to the Ichthys LNG Project.

AGC Thailand was contracted for the supply, fabrication and installation of all cryogenic, acoustic and hot insulation works for packages 4, 5 and 6 and pre-assembled modules.

The works were undertaken within CUEL's Module Fabrication Yard in Laemchabang, Chonburi, Thailand. Once mechanically complete, the preassembled modules were transported directly to Bladin Point in Darwin, Australia.

AusGroup continue to supply Scaffolding services to the INPEX project.





Karratha Gas Plant - Domestic Gas Multi-Discipline Services Agreement (MDSA)

AusGroup (AGC) was engaged by Woodside Energy to provide maintenance services at the North West Shelf Project's Domestic Gas Plant between 2013 and 2016.

AusGroup provided a Perth-based team of Karratha Life Extension ("KLE) program management resources, and a core crew of KLE site-based personnel. AGC also provided the management, supervision and craft labour team who undertook preoutage works. This included the recruitment and on-boarding of all shutdown staff.



Shell Prelude FLNG Hook-up & Commissioning Scaffolding and Rope Access

AusGroup (MAS) was engaged to commission scaffolding and rope access equipment for Shell's Prelude floating liquefied natural gas facility at Browse Basin, Western Australia. This engagement supported pre-investment activities in Australia, Korea and at offshore locations in 2016 and 2017.

In May 2021, AusGroup was awarded an extension to this contract to include; supervision, inspection, mechanical, welding, electrical & instrumentation, rigging, insulation, scaffolding and rope access.



APLNG Maintenance Scaffold supply and design and GLNG Maintenance Scaffold supply and design

Between 2015 and 2021 MAS was engaged to support the Australia Pacific LNG ("APLNG") project and the Gladstone LNG ("GLNG") project in 2015.

AusGroup (MAS) provided scaffolding material to the contracts' maintenance provider, UGL. The scope of work included the provision of over 200 tonnes of materials for APLNG and over 150 tonnes of materials for GLNG, together with technical advice, scaffold design and engineering support.



Chevron ABU Gorgon – Refractory, Mechanical, Electrical and Scaffolding Services

AusGroup (AGC) was engaged to undertake the first major turnaround project for Chevron's Gorgon project. AGC provided refractory, mechanical, electrical and scaffolding services and managed the complete WHRU multidisciplined project, including the removal and replacement of the PR compressor stack.

AusGroup also provided painting services and logistical transport support.



Chevron-operated Wheatstone Project Pipelay - Fabrication - Allotment 2

AusGroup (AGC) was awarded the supply and fabrication contract for offshore pipeline and subsea construction by Allseas Construction Contractors Australia - part of the Chevron-operated Wheatstone Project.

The work, undertaken between 2013 and 2015, was critical in the delivery of gas and condensate to the Wheatstone Platform in advance of it being transferred to the onshore LNG facility.

Ausgroup was also commissioned for the supply and fabrication of the Allotment 2 Wheatstone infield subsea pipeline end terminations, in line tees, pig launchers/receivers and abandonment/recovery heads.

The contract created at least 65 local jobs with the fabrication works for the project completed at AusGroup's Kwinana Operations and the Australian Marine Complex in Henderson, Western Australia.
