

Yara Pilbara Technical Ammonia Nitrate (TAN) Plant Recovery Project

The construction contract covers the deconstruction and construction of the dryers, heat exchangers and an absorption tower.

Integrated services include mechanical, electrical & instrumentation, welding, boilermaking, scaffolding, rigging, cranage, insulation, fabrication and sub-contractor management.

Full alignment with the client's goals was maintained across all aspects of the project.



FQM Ravensthorpe Nickel Operations Expansion Restart Works

AGC has been contracted to provide onsite Structural, Mechanical and Piping services to bring the Ravensthorpe Nickle plant out of care and maintenance and into operation.

AGC is also engaged in an early contractor involvement for a new ore handling and primary crushing facility, including an 8km overland conveyor.

In a collaborative approach we worked with the client through integrated teams on all aspects of the project.



FQM Ravensthorpe Shoemaker Levy Project - Truss Assembly

The scope involves the full assembly, alignment, construction verification and preparation for shipment for 33 pre-fabricated truss sections. Each of the sections was fabricated overseas and shipped to AGC's Kwinana facility where they were organised, assembled and outfitted with grating, handrail and idler rollers.



FQM Ravensthorpe Shoemaker Levy Project – Fabrication and SMP

AGC has been contracted as the sole supplier for fabricating select parts of the new construction project, and to provide on-site construction services - providing all required plant and equipment together with resources and management to execute the associated works.

The project involves the construction of Crushing Facilities, a nine kilometre overland conveyor and tie ins into existing operating conveyors.



FMG Water Tank Fabrication and Installation

In 2020, AGC completed a project for FMG to supply, fabricate, construct and install a 1.8 megalitre process water tank. The existing water tank had deteriorated from corrosion to an unacceptable level, which was at risk of structural failure.

The fabrication of the new tank was undertaken at AusGroup Kwinana Operations, and was completed over a 7-week period. The project included the supply and processing of tank components, rolling of plate steel and fabrication of associated pipework.



Liberty OneSteel Whyalla Steelworks Refractory Installation Services

AGC was awarded a three-year refractory services contract with Liberty OneSteel for site-wide management, planning and execution of preventative and reactive maintenance services.

The contracted scope of services included the provision of specialised teams to perform critical refractory scope and associated mechanical and access services to support of Liberty OneSteel's maintenance campaigns.



Alcoa of Australia Calciner Maintenance Contract

AGC was awarded a three year plus three- month extension on a calciner overhaul and maintenance contract with Alcoa Australia Limited.

Under the highly specialised Calciner Maintenance contract, AGC completed seventeen calciner outages at Alcoa's Kwinana, Pinjarra and Wagerup refineries.



Rio Tinto Cape Lambert Screen House Chutes

In 2019 AGC was engaged to provide critical services for the Cape Lambert Screenhouse Rebuild project. This included supply, fabrication, surface treatment and assembly of structural steel, platework, handrails, grating and associated mechanical works. The works were completed to an accelerated delivery schedule, with the crew working 24/7 to meet the deadline. The services formed part of the critical process for the client, and AGC utilised the full range of services available from the Kwinana facility to coordinate the successful delivery of all components.



Rio Tinto Rope Access Shutdown Maintenance Contract

In 2019 MAS was awarded a three year Rope Access Services contract with Rio Tinto.

Servicing Rio Tinto's Pilbara Iron Ore assets, MAS will leverage its expertise to deliver this specialised service. MAS' strategically located premises in Karratha will play a central role in responding and delivering operational services for all maintenance and shutdown events.

The project scope includes the supply of Rope Access personnel for services across all sites in Pilbara including structural, mechanical and piping maintenance activities, blasting and painting and NDT thickness testing.



MSP Engineering/Tianqi Lithium Kwinana Lithium Hydroxide Processing Plant (TLK LHPP1)

AGC was awarded the contract to provide structural, mechanical, piping, insulation and commissioning works on the LHPP1 Crystalliser building. With a peak workforce of 300 people, the project was supported by AGC's established Kwinana fabrication and manufacturing facility together with MAS resources to provide complete scaffolding access solutions.



Talison Lithium CGP2 Project - Structural, Mechanical and Piping installation

AGC was awarded a contract to install approximately 2,000+ tonnes of structural steel and associated flooring and cladding, approximately 70 tonnes of platework and approximately 450 pieces of mechanical equipment for the Talison Lithium project in 2018. The integrated scope of work included structural, mechanical and piping fabrication at AusGroup Kwinana Operations, with installation and Electrical and Instrumentation services at the Greenbushes mine site, WA.



Yara Pilbara Fertilisers Pty Ltd Major TAR – Refractory, Mechanical and Scaffolding Services

Yara Pilbara's ammonia plant performed a major turnaround in July 2018. During this period, AGC completed multiple works which ranged from minor pipe work, valve installation and vessel replacement, to major piping modifications in the critical areas of the plant. AGC delivered seventeen project scopes with its self-performed integrated offering, including providing Specialist Refractory Services, as well as sheet metal and fabrication support.
